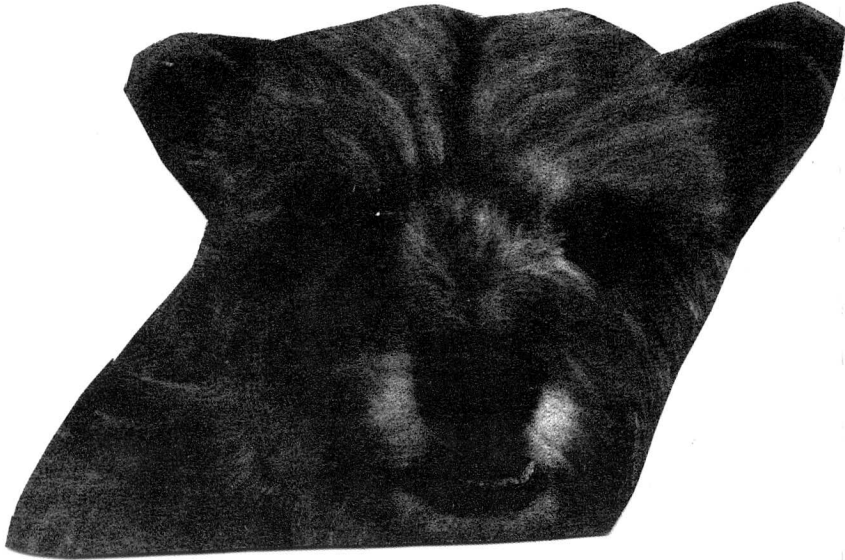

Since the beginning of their collaboration, Peter Fischli and David Weiss have given special consideration to the many artist books, special editions and multiples that have accompanied their projects of the past thirty years. This rich selection of printed matter, including proofs and storyboards for their publications and films, at once illustrates and constitutes a part of their oeuvre; through it one can trace the path of their creative process from concept to prototype and back again.

Julika Rudelius uses video to stage intimate, often disquieting monologues, interviews, and enactments, in which her subjects hold forth on their most private – and often embarrassing – thoughts and opinions. Rudelius' solo show at the Swiss Institute is the first U.S. presentation of her new two-channel video installation Forever, which she filmed in the Hamptons, the summer retreat of New York's high society, in 2006.
