From a distance the birds shake with action simultaneously anticipated and suspended. Up close, lines and marks shift forward, blurring boundaries while sharpening edges. The birds shoot upward - like they are flying. They oscillate between placidity and agitation. Staring directly into the birds' eyes causes the paintings to flatten out and the shapes to get heavy.

Nearby, puzzle-like compositions of linen-wrapped wood shapes act as a type of three-dimensional drawing with each frame serving as a literal tray for its contents.

Ryan Mrozowski received his MFA from the Pratt Institute in 2005, and his BFA from the Indiana University of Pennsylvania in 2003. Solo exhibitions include Arcade Gallery, London (2016); On Stellar Rays, New York, NY (2015); Art in General, Vilnius, Lithuania (2014); Pierogi, Brooklyn, NY (2012, 2010).
