(2005) New York. A sort of antimonument to the Stonewall riots of 1969, RIOT THE BAR was a nightly drinking party and chaotic program of music, dancing, bonfires, talks, games, etc., culminating in the bar being auctioned off and them promptly destroyed in a nearby field. This week-long collaboration between Bard summer MFA students and faculty was conceived and "choreographed" by performance artist Ei Arakawa, who was inspired by his memory of a failed gay pride march in Tokyo and subsequent encounter with the banality of official gay culture in New York.

(2007) Berlin. In-between monthly exhibitions, a week of Christopher Street Day Pride, a month of G8, RIOT THE BAR is RIOT THE 8 BARS. RIOT THE 8 BARS serve series of lectures, problems, entertainment, noise, dancing, and selling ϵ 2.5 cocktails every night at NGBK. The location of RIOT THE 8 BARS moves from inside the gallery to Oranienstrasse, from gateways and courtyard back to the white wall. This journey takes 8 days and includes the view of bookshop, gay pride in Kreuzberg, a car, and a copy machine.

RIOT THE 8 BARS is a performance of failed business. At the end of every night, RIOT THE 8 BARS project notes of own business accounting on the make-shift cinema-screen attached to the unstable bar structure. RIOT THE 8 BARS will be cut into pieces every night. RIOT THE 8 BARS will appear differently next day.

Questions: How to make a resisting action happen again a day after in a different place?How to represent, not to represent? How could we question monumentalization of Stonewall riot? How do you see American liberalism that is aging? What is the condition/discontent of gay rights/human rights in non-West? What "Oriental" means in 2007?
