

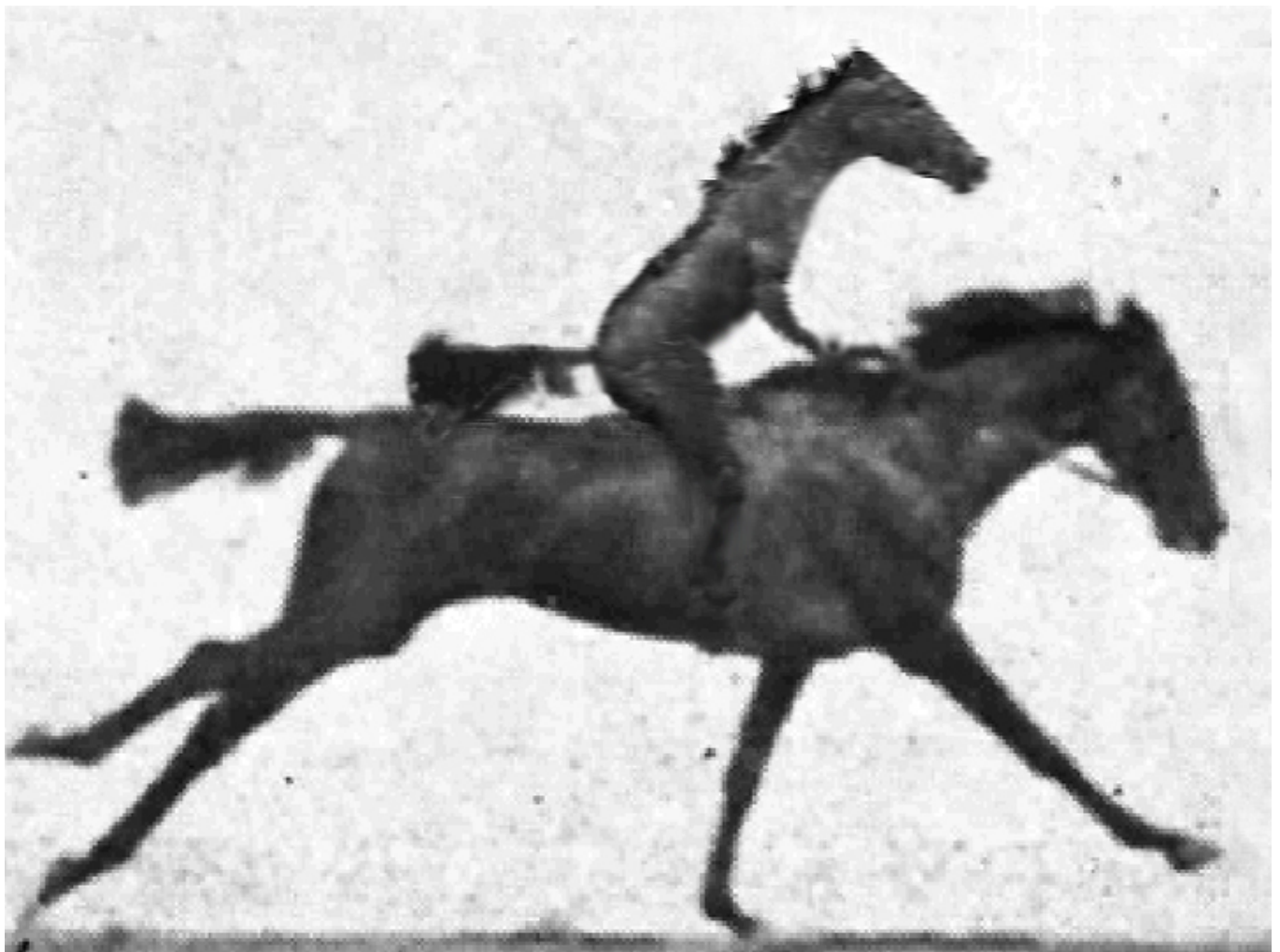

Hvad sker der, når vores perspektiv forskydes bare en anelse? Med poetisk legesyge udforsker Kim Beom sansningen af vores fælles verden i så forskellige medier som tegning, video, maleri, skulpturer, installation, tekst og bøger. Hos Kim Beom hænger alt sammen, mens intet er, hvad det ser ud til. Selv en lille ændring i et hverdagsobjekt kan omstyrte vores opfattelse. Gennem humor og små vittige ordspil viser han os det kendte i det ukendte og omvendt. Ved at ændre reglerne for, hvordan vi ser, fortolker og sanser, graver han både i vores indre psykologi og vores fælles virkelighed. I soloudstillingen *Water from Ganges River in the Cup Made with Newspaper from Congo* præsenterer Kunsthall Aarhus en bred vifte af Kim Beoms arbejde og tilgang til kunst for første gang på dansk jord.

What happens if our point of view is slightly twisted? With poetic playfulness Kim Beom explores the perception of our shared world. He works in various media, including drawing, video, painting, sculpture, installation, writing and books. Everything is tied together and nothing is what it appears to be. Even a small change to a well-known everyday object can alter our way of seeing it. Via humour and puns Kim Beom shows us the known in the unknown and vice versa. By changing the rules of how we see, interpret and sense things he investigates both our inner psychology and our shared reality. In the solo exhibition *Water from Ganges River in the Cup Made with Newspaper from Congo*, Kunsthall Aarhus presents for the first time in Denmark, a broad range of Kim Beom's work and his approach to making art.

Kim Beom (f. 1963, Sydkorea) har en bachelor og en master i kunst fra Seoul National University samt en master fra The School of Visual Arts i New York. Siden 1993 har hans værker været udstillet i hans hjemland fx på Art Sonje Center og Gallery Seoul og internationalt på Hayward Gallery i London, Creative Workshop and Gallery i Singapore, Shiseido Gallery Tokyo i Japan og Istanbul Biennalen i Tyrkiet.
