We are pleased to announce Lin May Saeed's sixth solo exhibition with the gallery.

Lin May Saeed works with so called poor materials such as styrofoam, plaster, papers and tool steel. Her sculptures, reliefs and installations with silhouette revolve around the beginning of human culture and its basic conflicts. She tells us stories about the struggle of human supremacy at the expenses of animals and resources. Animals and animal rights are the main subjects of her work. In 2006 she started with the series "The Liberation of animals from their cages", which shows the moment of the animal liberation or the peaceful coexistence of humans and animals after the liberation. Iconographical the motives are inspired by the logo of the "Animal Liberation Movement" of the mid 1970ies. Still proceeding, this work complex contains 18 works by now, utilizing a wide range of media.

Using an expressive visual language Lin May Saeed's critical works shine light on the power structures and prompt the viewers to renew their thinking and actions.
