Focusing her energies on experimenting with the physical and psychological properties within the space of a discrete work, the presently exhibited paintings are notable for their balance of material play and somber subjectivity. In addition to her gallery exhibitions, Hewitt has collaborated with Tokyo-based jewelry and clothing designer Yoshiyo Abbe of Petite Robe Noire.
