2. **Ua Nani Ha'ena** (choreography by Chinky Mahoe)

A hula from Kaua'i, a love chant about Pele meeting her dream lover in her sleep.

3. **Pana'ewa** (choreography by Sonny Ching)

A hula from Big Island, a battle between Hi'iaka, Pele's youngest sister and Panaewa, a wicked demigod.

4. **Hana Waimea** (choreography by Nani Lim Yap)

A hula about the great Kamehameha trained his warriors in very adverse conditions.

5. **Na Uwe O Na Manu** (choreography by Darrell Lupenui)

A hula about native Hawaiian birds.

A hula about David La'amea Kalakaua, the last king of Hawaii.
