I forbindelse med udstillingen **Systemics #4: Aarhus Rapport – Avantgarde as network (or, the politics of the ultralocal)** afholder Kunsthall Aarhus et dagsseminar. Arrangementet er udviklet og modereret af Marianne Ping Huang (Aarhus Universitet).

Forestillingen om avantgarden som en kunstnerisk, social og politisk kraft, der opererede på kanten af historien er blevet udfordret af et nyt fokus på det 20. århundredes avantgardebevægelser. I løbet af det sidste årti er avantgardens taktikker og begivenheder blevet konceptuelt, teoretisk og historisk gen-undersøgt og -opført som en del af netværksbaserede geografier og historier. Seminaret *Avantgarde as Network* fortsætter undersøgelerne og diskuterer forskellige aspekter af denne genopfindelse.
