### A Circus of One

### Alison Crocetta

In a circus divested of its customary pageantry and spectacle, we meet a methodical performer whose actions endure rather than entertain - marrying intrigue and enigma to reformulate how we see, and see ourselves. This is the work and mission of Alison Crocetta, a Columbus-based artist who orchestrates a promenade of performances, short films, photographs and environments through the material language of sculpture. Every object and exercise are carefully composed in this poetic arena, slowly accumulating substance as Crocetta translates the movement of her body into a series of meditations that marry subject and surroundings. And while a palpable quietude characterizes her work, Crocetta interrupts the stillness with breath, song and the human being. The passage of time thickens in this interconnected arena, where she also crafts every performance garment and related objects to function as collaborators instead of mere props. In this spare but omnipresent circus the body simultaneously organizes and reflects its surroundings to prompt questions about the realities we inform via simple, yet profound actions. A Circus of One is Crocetta's first survey exhibition, spanning her performance-driven work from the past twenty-five years, and premiering the second act of this titular project, which the artist will perform in the gallery on select dates. The exhibition will also feature the debut of RESONATOR - an amplification box built to the proportions of the artist's body so that it may, like the show as a whole, project Crocetta's voice as she navigates the aural orbit of her singular circus.
