The sculptures are made with a plastic model making material and coated with many layers of acrylic primer. Each one hosts an arrangement of horizontal stripes that have been built up with a small brush. All works in this series are open and empty.

A wall has been constructed at the entrance of the exhibition space, extending the procedure of arrival. Thin white curtains cover most of the windows. In the front room is a single grey work which is oiled with an engine oil — a type of oil intended for vintage car motors. In the back room three sculptures are displayed across two plinths: two small beige works, which have been sitting open for years, and a white sculpture that is primed heavily and is white like it's plinth. At the back of the exhibition space is a photograph of an invitation from a previous exhibition.
