It has been suggested that the pun with “Here Comes the Son” is already embedded in it, as a reference to Harrison’s Oedipal conflict with John Lennon. “Here Comes the Sons” is presented simultaneously with “C-A-N-V-A-S, Jerry Magoo, Uhutrust and Guardian.co.uk Paintings” at **Greene Naftali Gallery**, 508 W. 26<sup>th</sup> St., New York, October 20-November 19.

The series of small paintings on display are replicas of works by Kate Middleton, the daughter-in-law of the King of England. Middleton and her husband, Prince William, held a charity painting workshop for Inner City Arts in Los Angeles.
