Over the past years Hadassah Emmerich has explored relations between exoticism and libidinality. In terms of *excess* the concepts merge, like bodies entangled. In her paintings and murals Hadassah aims to unite various perspectives surrounding female sexuality and desire, combining the power of sensual images with the self-awareness of the desiring gaze of the viewer. Identity, the body, repetition and fragmentation are recurrent elements in the patterned mural that Hadassah Emmerich has specifically designed to fit Manifold Books' main wall.

Through colour and monumentality Hadassah's paintings celebrate female sexuality beyond youth and fertility.
