Touching has taken on a special meaning in our lives over the past year. How multi-layered a touching and letting go can be, can be seen from October 29, 2021, in the exhibition *Touch Release* by 21 students and alumni of Haegue Yang's class at the Hochschule für Bildende Künste-Städelschule in Frankfurt am Main.

Marked by the specific circumstances of its production, the group exhibition **Touch Release** at the Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden forms the very first physical union of artists who have shared a past trajectory but who, due to the pandemic and the closed studios, have not had a common physical point of contact for a long time. At the junction of site-specific installation, painting, sculpture, video, and sound, the works speak sometimes of strong proximity, sometimes of distance.

The exhibition breaks away from a merely physical notion of touch and replaces it with a nuanced understanding of what it means to approach, connect, and let go. It understands intimacy as a political concept and touch as a play of forces that defines not only the body but also the object. In times where the forces that govern the public body and its inner workings are in a state of flux, the exhibition explores the tensions between seemingly impermeable structures and their actual porosity, between proximity and otherness. The exhibition was realised in collaboration with **Tom Engels**: "Together, we asked ourselves whether we could think of touch differently, reaching beyond the restrained meaning it has come to bear. Not as a technical tool that remedies or aggravates public well-being, but as a bountiful entanglement of movement, belonging, and intention. How touch not only brushes upon the body but also permeates it. How within such motion, social, political, and psychological vectors impress and leave traces. To find the direction where touch itself shapes."

Haegue Yang reflects on the exhibition of its students and alumni: "Among young artists there is no doubt an inevitable concern about the idea of



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touch. Touch can also be said to be a kinship, which is essential both metaphorically and literally for practicing artists, especially the young. **Touch Release** distances itself from the conventional format of an art student exhibition, which usually centers around the professor. The exhibition triggers new points of touch, articulating the attitudes of the next generation and their sense of the present."

"The exhibition **Touch Release** at the Nassauischer Kunstverein in Wiesbaden puts its finger on a red-hot topic: the dynamics of proximity and distance. Self-isolation and community in a confined space have accompanied us in this pandemic. The exhibition with the ambivalent title opens a space of experience for visitors in which proximity can be explored as a powerful social, aesthetic and not least political phenomenon. I am particularly pleased that students and alumni of the Städel School professor **Haegue Yang**, a former scholarship holder of the Hessische Kulturstiftung, are exploring the dynamics of touching and being touched at the Nassauischer Kunstverein," says **Eva Claudia Scholtz**, managing director of the Hessische Kulturstiftung, whose support made the realization of the exhibition possible.

The Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden has had a close cooperation with the Frankfurt Städelschule for many years, "the chance to experience very young artists, who experience part of their training together in one class, together in an exhibition is a highlight in the exhibition year of the Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden. We are particularly pleased to be able to present and discover the class of the fascinating artist Haegue Yang, who already exhibited at the Kunstverein in 2002, in a very touching and at the same time liberating thematic exhibition after a long and intensive preparation", **Elke Gruhn**, artistic director of the Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden.
