
Surplus Tension

Hannah Levy (b. 1991, New York) brings to The Arts Club of Chicago a series of works in her signature materials of nickelplated steel and silicone. All but one were made exclusively for The Arts Club's rooms, which Levy recognizes for their luxuriant finishes. The terrazzo, travertine, lacquer, leather, silk and velvet that characterize The Arts Club's building, inherited from architect Ludwig Mies van der Rohe, contrast with popular ideas about the minimalism of the mid-century aesthetic. Indeed, by using reflection in the highly polished floors or by engaging with ceiling and structural surfaces, Levy focuses our attention on the grittier, more corporeal underside of the familiar features of modernism. Her sculptures conjure images of indulgent parties, daring sex play, or taboo desire. They resemble or depart from familiar household, bodily, or animal shapes; we recognize claws, chairs, a swing, chandelier, or tent. Yet there are also subtler clues embedded in the constructions—the texture of a crocodile, the ties of a corset, or the armature of a bat's wing. These take a moment to discover—or to embody and lead us to physically encounter Levy's conception of pleasure through the curve of metal or its contact with fleshly silicone skins.
