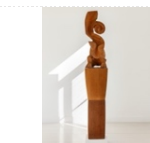




Michael Lekakis

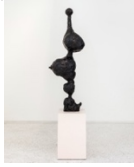
