
#### **Landscape with a Man Killed by a Snake** —Neal Vandenbergh February 26 – April 10, 2022

For Landscape With A Man Killed By A Snake Vandenbergh has created a new body of large scale works on paper expanding on the artist's rigorous drawing practice. Dexterously rendered snakes, transparent faces, bashful politicians with ruby eyes, and floating heads in glowing orbs become repeating motifs building towards something menacing beyond the frame. Hallucinatory revelation distorts visual experience and social relationships both personal and political. Like the Nicholas Poussin painting from which the exhibition takes its title from the work in the exhibition offers imagery that is at once alluring and alienating.
























