About the space :

Cherish is a project space in Geneva founded by Mohamed Almusibli, James Bantone, Thomas Liu Le Lann and Ser Serpas from their shared living space. It is now run by Mohamed Almusibli, James Bantone and Marguerite Mikanowski. The space occupies a rather dormant, figuratively homely and quaint domicile both in its architecture and planning as a family home.
