

You can find the answers to your questions by using the YOUR FATE dice.

First prepare yourself to throw the dice. You may choose to form a question. You may choose to empty your mind. Be sure you are ready.

Shake all twenty-five dice together and toss them onto a flat surface. Some of the dice will fall with a sign facing up; these are the signs that can help you with your questions.

The red die represents you, the one who questions. The position of the red die within the over all pattern will indicate how the signs relate to you.

There are eight “variable” signs: Lock, Unlock; Small, Big; Exit, Enter; Down, and UP. These “variable” signs will modify the value of the other signs depending on their relative proximity.

Suggested interpretations of all signs are outlined in this book.

MAN: Self, significant person be it enemy or friend, husband father figure, son, brother, co-worker, stranger.



WOMAN: Self, significant person be it enemy or friend, wife, mother figure, daughter, sister, coworker, stranger.



WORLD: All of nature, acts of god, one's environment, one's place, one's legacy, the people one is surrounded by, the earth, everything known to exist, the greater whole.



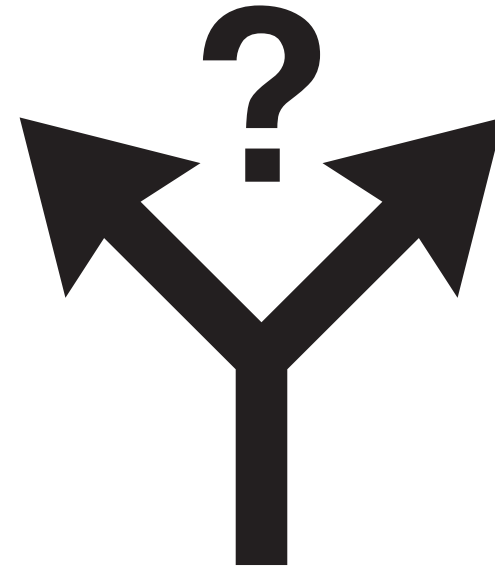
HOME: Where one lives, with whom one lives, one's daily life, those on is around most, where one spends most of one's time, where one feels most safe, where one puts down one's roots culture and tradition, parents, children, brothers and sisters.



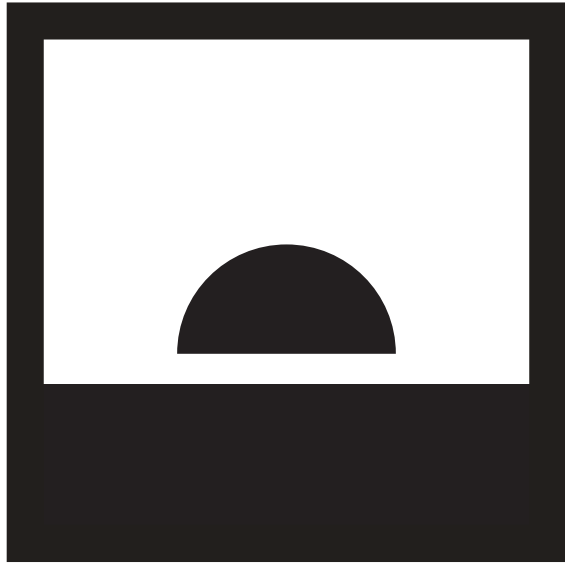
HEART: Emotions, emotional self, emotional relationships, pleasure, love, sex, desire, intimacy, passion bliss, loyalty, family love, love of an occupation or activity, creativity, giving, spontaneity, play, enchantment, procreation.



LEGAL: Justice, right and wrong, government, matters agreed upon by law, civility, responsibility, adjustments to situations, legal actions, agreements, contracts, settlements, resolutions, divorce, marriage, equilibrium, balance between logic and emotion, balance between worldly and spiritual affairs, fairness, clarity, straightforward choices, detached observation, mediation.



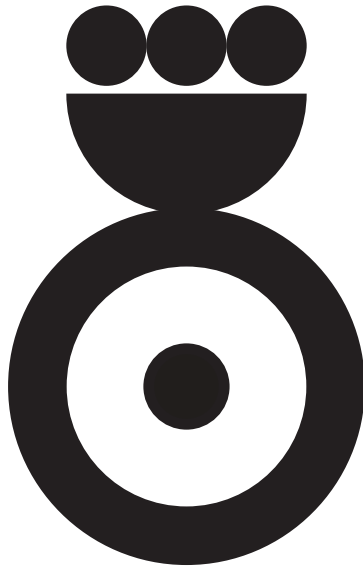
CHOICE: Crossroads, a decision between alternatives, to be made soon, pondering and contemplation, opening up of new ways, opportunities, dilemmas.



SUNSET/SUNRISE: The big picture, the overview, long term goals, visions of the future, eventual outcomes, completions, the end, the beginning, opportunities, breakthroughs, transformations, birth, death.



STAR: Recognition, social status, appreciation by others, kudos, regards, tangible manifestations of one's identity in the world, success, ambition, how one is known, one's role in the community, promotion, career, advances, culmination of work and experience, achievement of goals, a sense of being fulfilled, wholeness, self-realization.



DESTINY: Heaven, fate in the universe, union, reunion, awakening, personal growth, hope, the unknowable, the divine, the end, the beginning, religion, philosophies and belief systems, things having a reason, the really big picture, the way things should be or will be, long distance travel, cosmic consciousness.



SUBJECTIVE: The outside world as seen from within, personal points of view, projections, inner reality, sense of self, psyche, mental health, prejudices, beliefs, expectations, preconceptions, unquestioned assumptions, identity construction, memories, dreams.

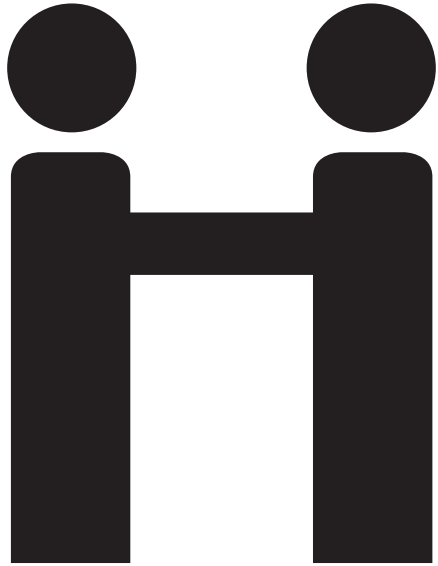


FALSE FACE: Lies, betrayals, deceit, secret enemies, bad influence, seeing things falsely, mistakes, hidden truths, secret admirers, seductions, things behind the scenes.



JOKER: The unexpected, the monkey wrench, foolishness, the unpredictable, chance, accidents, serendipity, blunders, false logic, vanity, surprises, irony, humor, impulsiveness, thoughtlessness, bad luck, good luck.





PARTNERS: Business relationships, marriage, interactions with others, equality, commitments to others, group achievements, shared purposes, cooperation, community projects, social identity, contractual obligations, alliances, shifts away from self-interest.



COMMUNICATION: Transmissions of information, messages, conductors, flow, unseen currents, trust, meetings, being in touch, people one is in touch with, socializing, exploring, short journeys, listening, learning, sources in the past, keeping the lines open, expression of intentions, clarity, meaning, language, symbols, indicators.



POSSESSIONS: Money, investments, objects, identification with things, ownership, resources, special skills and talents, self esteem, material security, nourishment, necessities, attachments.



V.I.P.: An important person, a person of influence, a person of great wisdom or courage, father, mother, boss, leader, someone who can open up worlds or close them down, a nemesis, a savior, a vanquisher, a supporter, a destroyer, an agent of change.



HEALTH: Issues with the body, mental or physical wellbeing, healing, exercise, stamina, strength, tenacity, fertility, coping ability, stability, longevity.



FRAGILE: A sensitive situation, instability, imbalance, vulnerability, breakability, weakness, susceptibility to change, worry, disappointment.



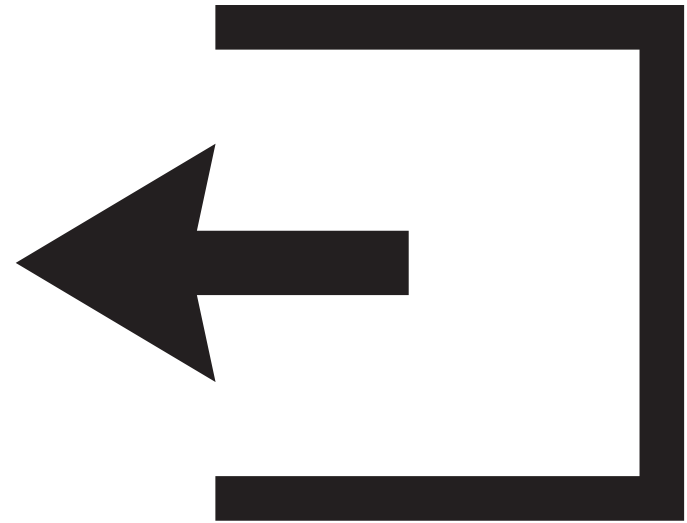
CHAOS: Elemental power, nature, the uncontrolled forces in the unconscious, lack of control or decisiveness, disorientation, befuddlement, disorder.



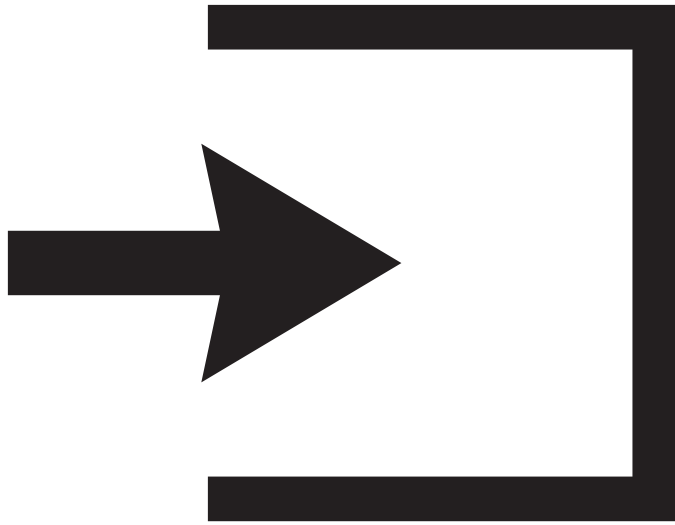
LOCK: Caught in a pattern, stuck, trapped frozen, focus, steadiness, determination, being “on track”.



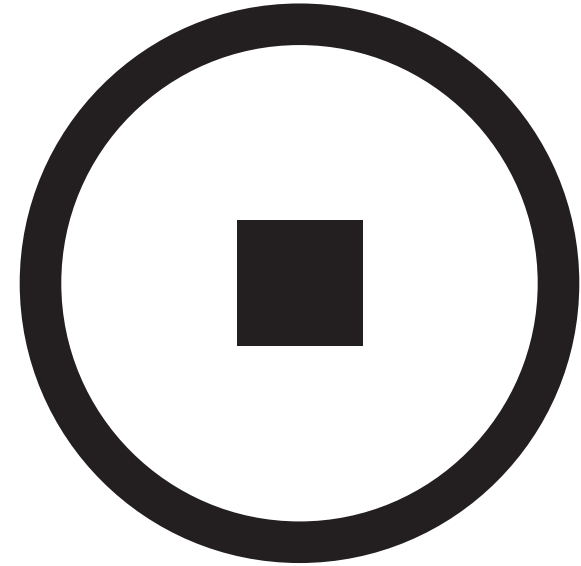
UNLOCK: Release from a pattern, a breaking out, new growth, freedom and change.



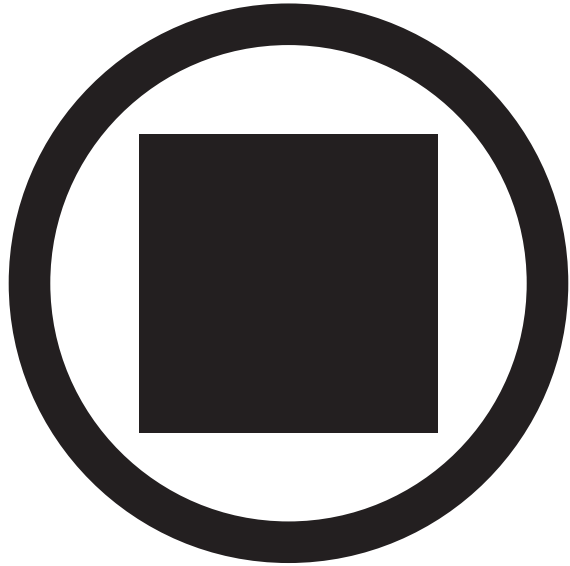
EXIT: Leaving a situation or a phase, an end, an escape, a calling away, a shedding of old skins, a giving up of the old, an expulsion.



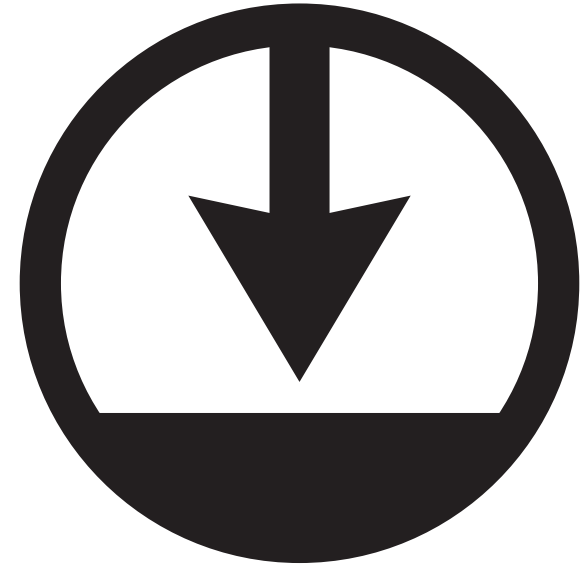
ENTER: New phase or situation, new interests, a beginning, an approaching, an invitation, revelation, parting the veil, discovery, initiation, evolution.



SMALL: Weak, not too significant, minor.

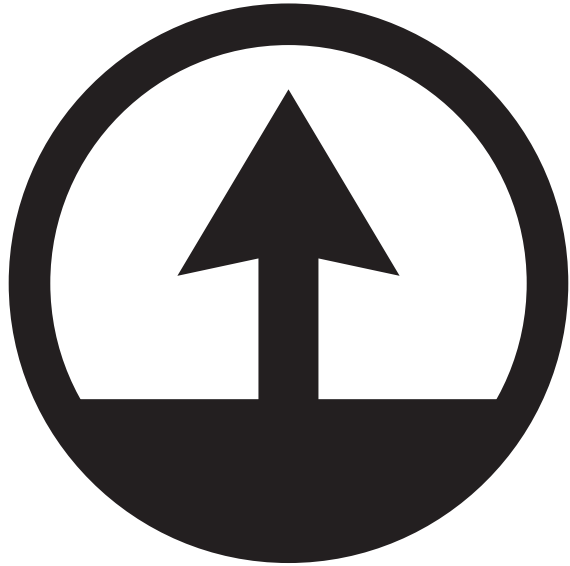


BIG: Strong, very significant, large.
