A.D.NYC presents Joshua Abelow featuring Joshua Boulos.

For the exhibition Abelow debuts a suite of four paintings from 2021 based on an early childhood drawing of *E.T. the extraterrestrial*.

Accompanying the paintings are two sculptural sound works by Providence based artist Joshua Boulos.

As a continuation of their collaboration, Joshua Abelow & Joshua Boulos will have an upcoming two-person exhibition at King's Leap in New York, NY.

The exhibition at A.D.NYC opens in concurrence with solo and two-person exhibitions at five venues this spring. Each exhibition will present a unique facet of the artist's work, providing a comprehensive showcase of Abelow's multivalent and deeply collaborative practice.

Joshua Abelow (b. 1976, Frederick, MD) earned his MFA from the Cranbrook Academy of Art in 2008 and his BFA from the Rhode Island School of Design in 1998. Recent exhibitions were held at Jir Sandel, Copenhagen, DK; Anthony Greaney, Somerville, MA; Magenta Plains, New York, NY; Sydney, Sydney, AU; Apartment 13, Providence, RI; Harkawik, Los Angeles, CA; Et al. San Francisco, CA; James Fuentes, New York, NY and Halsey McKay, East Hampton, NY.

Abelow's work has been included in numerous group exhibitions internationally. The artist has several published books including Painter's Journal (2012), ART FICTION (2013), DRAWINGS DRAWINGS (2018), and Good Morning (2018). From 2010 to 2015, Abelow ran ART BLOG ART BLOG, which functioned as an art blog, temporary gallery, print publication, and sculpture. Additionally, the artist is known as the proprietor of Freddy, a curatorial project he founded in Baltimore (2014). Abelow lives and works in Harris, NY and New York, NY.

Joshua Boulos (b. 1999) is a Hawaiian artist based in Providence, RI. He is the founder of Providence based project space Apartment 13. Recent exhibitions include "Minor Rationalism" at Baader Meinhof, Group Exhibition 2 at the Fall River Museum of Contemporary Art, "Poi Dogs/At Play" at Triest, and Sinkhole Project.
