Tommaso Corvi-Mora is pleased to present an exhibition of new work by British artist Sam Bakewell, his first at the gallery.

The exhibition consists of a group of abstract sculptures made of parian clay exploring the concepts of process, waste, the passing of time, the handmade and the weight of colour.

Sam Bakewell earned an MA in Ceramics & Glass from the Royal College of Art in 2011. In 2015 he won the BCB AWARD at the British Ceramic Biennial and took part in the Jerwood Makers Open in 2017. In 2018 he participated in the European Ceramic Context at the Bornholm Kunstmuseum, Denmark. He is currently Artist in Residence at the Ceramics Galleries, Victoria & Albert Museum (until July 2019).
