In Gymnasia, Goldberg/Hertz/Peters/Schrader, work collaboratively (what Hegel and Phil Jackson call "the I that is We and the We that is I"), transforming Cleopatra's into a modular apparatus cum seminar room to create a hybridized space, a gymnasium in the traditional sense, where you would go to exercise, socialize, and debate. Here, "working through" applies to both intellectual discourse and exercise regimen, sculpting happens to both art and bodies.

Mapping the Pilates machine "Cadillac" onto Giacometti's "The Palace at 4 a.m., we arrive at our current environment. Throughout the duration of the show, artists, writers, academics, and fitness instructors will hold sessions in their field of interest where participants can bend and extend their minds and bodies as one.

In Kathy Acker's text, "The Language of the Body," she attempts to write about her experience as a bodybuilder, but repeatedly fails. "After each workout, I forgot: to write. Repeatedly. I...some part of me...the part of the 'I' who bodybuilds... was rejecting language, any verbal description of the processes of bodybuilding." To Acker, bodybuilding and language are posited in antagonistic terms. Here, re-activated by gymnasia, is the proposition that an immersive art object can out stand the either or of mind and matter.

The notion of failure is central to improvement in both zones. You warm up, work your way through a regiment until you reach the limit at which failure emerges. Work it out. Rinse and repeat.

The gymnasium used to be a place for physical and intellectual education. Somewhere along the way they were separated and we've taken it for granted that it's always been that way. Physiology and ontology will once again meet at contrology.
