The 'protagonists' of the exhibition are, therefore, everyday objects and their unique, physical attributes; in an attempt to organize anew the commonly recognized and accepted understanding of these objects. Through repeated gestures, the fundamental functions of 'things' are discovered, leading to a synthesis of their subjective meanings. With basic rules of physics, the artist arrives at conclusions regarding the imperfections of perception and the accidental nature of experiencing reality. The inevitable human error of every repetition creates anomalies thus redefining the subject of the inquiry: a thing is 'that' thing because the exception disabled it from being anything else.

The exhibition was organized by Kris Latocha and it will be accompanied by Honza Zamojski's new artist-book 'One Two One Two', published by Latocha's KLTB.
