MONSTERS serves as a tangential addendum to *Eclipse Body & Soul Syntax*. Using the same scanning process as before, Relph gathered 1,000 images of payphone enclosures in New York and Los Angeles. For the book Relph and designer Joseph Gilmore assembled an edit of 452 images, with the sequence beginning on the front cover, and ending on the back. The page numbers are accompanied by another set of numbers which correspond to an individuated xerox copy of each image, which Relph is making available through his Seeing Plastic imprint.

The pieces on Beast developed out of Holtkamp's creation in 2016 of an audio-visual performance that centers on the physical properties of light via 3D laser projections. Holtkamp created a system that intricately links every aspect of the performance, from the modular synth and virtual instruments to the constantly shifting projections of his "Color Phase" light installations. Beast Vol. 1 was recorded in real time and is presented with minimal edits to divide it into three pieces. It is the slightly rawer and more abandoned of the two volumes.
