Living As at Loggia marks the first presentation of Sangt Hipolyt outside of Berlin. Sangt Hipolyt is an independent art space in Berlin-Wedding founded in 2018 by the artist Burkhard Beschow. Living As is a survey of the past two years at Sangt Hipolyt. It features the work of all artists who have exhibited there and some who will be shown in the near future. The front room at Loggia displays works from each of the twelve exhibitions at Sangt Hipolyt. The sequence follows the timeline of the space's activity. It begins with Zac Segbedzi's T-shirt edition marking the space's naissance in April 2018 and continues counter-clockwise. At the desk the visitor can take a virtual tour of Burkhard Beschow's 2019 exhibition Aditus – all documentation photos are by Paul Barsch, as well as the screensaver. The back room features artists that are yet to show at the space, as well as a work by Anne Fellner, whose studio is home to Sangt Hipolyt.
