Gritli Faulhaber (*1990, Freiburg im Breisgau) lives and works in Zürich. *Militant Joy* is an ongoing series initiated in 2019, originally painted in the time between production of other works with historical or pop cultural references. Recent and upcoming solo exhibitions include Istituto Svizzero, Milan (2023), Sangt Hipolyt, Berlin (2020), and Cherish, Geneva (2019). Faulhaber studied at HfGB, Leipzig and ZHdK, Zürich.
