Tables: Wisrah Villefort

Initially researching the presence of plastic debris in Lake Geneva to think of the semiotic divergences of pollution between the Global South and North, Wisrah Villefort presents now a body of work conceived during their time at La Becque that considers a broader ecology. Yet still having the lake as a departure, the pieces displayed during the open studios also comment on territory, ownership, object value, material fluxes, and the artist's condition and agency in participating in such dynamics. While, for example, in **Tables** (2022), one can hear their voice overlapped with found sound bits directly linked to the lake, in **Bottoms** (2022), a set of piggy bank bottoms is composed based on more abstract criteria choices such as color, shape, and materiality.

Wisrah Villefort (1989, Buritizeiro, Brazil) lives and works in São Paulo, Brazil. Recent projects include solo exhibitions at BPA, Cologne; Liste, Basel; GUAVA, Brasilia; Goswell Road, Paris; and group ones at Toxi Space, Zurich; SALTS, Basel, OLHÃO, São Paulo; MASSIMO, Milan; 14th Curitiba Biennial; Curitiba. Upcoming projects include Kadist with Persona Curada, Paris; Center d'Art Waza, Lubumbashi; and SIMIAN, Copenhagen. Institutional collections and commissions include Kadist, France; National Museum of the Republic, Brazil; The One Minutes Foundation at the Sandberg Instituut, The Netherlands; and Instituto Moreira Salles, Brazil.
