KATHY TEMIN Wall Works 21 April - 27 March 2023

Eight plush wall sculptures, rangng in scale from small to large are unified in a dusty pink palate. The works are individually sewn, stuffed, and made from Temin's signature medium of synthetic fur: soft, cuddly, toylike, artificial; challenging conventions of both taste and art history. Craft activities from the 1970s are combined with minimalism that includes the grid, repetition, and the monochrome as objects for personal and collective remembering.

The exhibition *Wall Works* invokes notions of suburbia and interior design, structured around the ten-sion between the familiar and the strange, the organic and the artificial, the sentimental and the monumental, remembrance and play.
