A world of woods, processed for remarkable effects. Crown cut birch shows straight grain against symmetrically book-matched cathedrals. Bold varied designs dance around rasterized annual rings of rotary sliced beech. The variegated pattern of flat sawn ash tree. All together 17 square yards of the finest silks. Jimmy Robert (b. 1975, Guadeloupe) is a graduate of Goldsmiths, University of London, and the Rijksakademie, Amsterdam. He has exhibited at 5th Berlin Biennale of Contemporary Art, Berlin; Tate Britain, London; WIELS, Brussels; Art:Concept, Paris; CCA Kitakyushu Project Gallery, Japan; Cubitt Gallery, London; Neuer Aachen Kunstverein, Germany; MoMA in New-York; CAC Bretigny, France and Diana Stigter, Amsterdam. Jimmy Robert was the 2009 laureate of the Follow Fluxus–After Fluxus grant. His most recent solo shows were at Jeu de Paume, Paris; the Museum of Contemporary Art (MCA), Chicago; and the Power Plant, Toronto.
