Foxy Production presents *wildlife*, the first New York solo exhibition of Madrid-based artist, Teresa Moro. In a new series of paintings and works on paper, Moro explores the cushioned architecture of everyday life. Moro creates isolated and huddled groups of beds, sofas and chairs that foreground a contemporary desire for comfort, social withdrawal and impassivity.

Moro's soft architecture frames the absent body while possessing anthropomorphic and metaphysical qualities. Gold is over-laid with muted color to produce shimmering soft haloes in spaces without depth or graphic clarity. Moro executes a troubling aesthetic that makes the banal appear transcendent, producing beautiful and disturbing icons of leisure.

Teresa Moro was educated at Universidad Complutense De Madrid and Chelsea College of Art, London. She has exhibited at the Museo de la Ciudadela, Pamplona; Fundacion de Cultura de la Diputación Provincial de Cadiz; Museo Municipal, Albacete; Cervantes Institute, Munich; Museo De Bellas Artes, Oviedo; Senate Palaté, Museo de la Real Academia de Bellas Artes de San Fernando, Madrid; **IVAM**, Centre del Carmen, Valencia. She has received awards from The City of Cadiz; Premio De Pintura Y Estultura Fundación Del Fútbol Profesional, Madrid; and the Canada-Blanch Foundation, Valencia. Her work has been featured in *Terna Celeste*, *El Pais* and *El Mundo*, and is held in private and public collections, including the Judith Rothschild Foundation, New York; Museo Union Fenosa, La coruna; Museo Extremeño e Iberoamericano de Arte Contemporaneo, Badajoz; The City Council of Madrid; Todisa Collection, Madrid; Coca-Cola Foundation, Madrid.
