White Flag Library is pleased to present an exhibition of new work by Dena Yago. The exhibition will open with a free public reception Saturday evening, September 6, from 6–8 PM and continue through October 18, 2014.

Based in writing and poetry, Dena Yago's work tethers objects and images to ground language in explicit everyday encounters. Thinking through co-habitation and survivalism in contemporary urban environments, Yago playfully inverts common metonymic usage. From the intimate, identity-forming use of proper nouns, to the detached ambiguity of common nouns, meaning slides between the specific and abstract, altering relational proximity.

Dena Yago has presented recent solo exhibitions with Cubitt, London; Eli Ping, New York; Gasconade, Milan; Malraux's Place, New York; and Sandy Brown, Berlin. Her work has been presented as part of numerous group exhibitions including *A Matter of Taste*, Dingum, Paris; *Revelry*, Kunsthalle Bern; *BLOOMINGTON: MALL OF AMERICA, NORTH SIDE OF FOOD COURT, ACROSS FROM BURGER KING & THE BANK OF PAYPHONES THAT DON'T TAKE INCOMING CALLS*, Bortolami, New York; *Bathrobe Baden, Staatliche Kunsthalle Baden-Baden; Roman à clef, Bodega, Philadelphia; and Combine #1*, Cage, New York. Yago's work has been discussed in Mousse, Frieze d/e, and Rhizome. She received her B.A. from Columbia University and currently lives and works in Los Angeles.
