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## storefront: Full Haus: The Seeld Library

For this iteration of *storefront:*, Full Haus—an artist-run space in Los Angeles established by Becca Lieb and David Muenzer in 2015—presents the work of the Seeld Library. Initiated by Los Angeles-based artist Jeffrey Stucker, the Seeld Library brings together a community of thinkers whose scholarship explores topics ranging from monstrous births in the 17th century and their



medicine and colonial exploitation. For *storefront:*, the Seeld Library will display objects, ephemeral printed matter, and handwritten notes within a meticulously fabricated environment that resembles library storage and reflects the project's unusual and probing approach to scholarship.
