Circus Lodge

3rd September -8th October 2023 Roland Ross is pleased to present 'Circus Lodge', a new installation by Maria Gorodeckaya incorporating reworked garments of clothing, imprinted glass, a sound work and a publication.

'Circus Lodge' centres around what a person leaves behind. Partly consisting of items the artist has collected and recomposed from what she has found or been given in the wake of a relationship, that for her act as documents of past events.

Verging on the obsessive, the works in this exhibition play with the idea of a romanticised figure or muse, historically female, but in this case, presumably male. These objects set the stage for a fantasy scenario that explores the power dynamics between artist and subject.

'Circus Lodge' may thus appear to both feed the urge for and represent a strategy to reinstate agency when faced with an impossible object of desire.
