

Yves Scherer *Eternity*

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
Yves Scherer [b. 1987, Switzerland] is a Swiss contemporary artist living and working in New York. He graduated from the Royal College of Art, London in 2014 with an MA in Sculpture, after receiving a BA in Sciences of Culture from the University of Lucerne.

His work has been presented at international institutions such as ICA London, Kunsthalle Basel, Swiss Institute NY, Kunstverein Wiesen, Kunsthaus Grenchen and Basement Roma. He has had solo shows at Guido Baudach, Berlin [2019, 2016, 2014]; Cassina Projects, NY [2018]; Golsa Gallery, Oslo [2020, 2018]; José Garcia, Mexico City [2015] amongst others. He received the Swiss Art Award [2015]

Galería Mascota is pleased to open its new exhibition *Eternity* by contemporary artist Yves Scherer. While Scherer's practice has previously been concerned with celebrity culture, observing the blurred boundaries between public and private life, Eternity is a more intimate reflection on the reality of family life, fatherhood and the artists own lived environment.

Previously using images of celebrities, from model Kate Moss to actress Emma Watson, as way of exploring the dystopia of online culture and fandom, Eternity is instead a collection of domestic life snap shots. For example, presented as the first work in the show we see a portrait of the artists' own daughter Lucy in a large lenticular, paired an image of the artists own hand reaching out with a single flower. Meanwhile in another corner of the gallery, a sculpture of a pet cat sits quietly, again with the artists own hand affectionately reaching out to stroke it.

Eternity may offer the audience a chance to consider the eternal character of 'family', as well the eternally changing reality. Alternatively, the exhibition title may also be a meditation on the traditional methods of art making themselves, as we can see Scherer explores through the classical trope of the nude statue, as well as oil on canvas paintings.

To emphasize the unique relationship between our innermost worlds and the public lives we all share, Yves Scherer employs a medium that reveals these relations' transient and ambivalent nature, presenting an iconography of symbols that coexist and repel each other at the same time.

Scherer's vision of the place and landscape from which he originates, becomes ever the more attractive through eyes of painters like Emmenegger, Dietrich or Amiet, and share similarities with the German romantic idea of the home as a magic space- as a place out of the present "here".

In the contemporary landscape marked by a perpetual crisis, Scherer's practice serves as evidence of a form of escapism that characterizes the current generation. We are frequently offered the opportunity to live and project ourselves in an endless "present", another time in another place where things exist and happen but are yet to come.



Scherer's paintings present us not with entire landscapes, but with intimate details of an often-idealised nature.

In a conversation with the artist, I learned that the paintings are inspired by historical Swiss landscape painters such as Hans Emmengger, Adolf Dietrich and Cuno Amiet, who interestingly was born in Scherer's hometown of Solothurn.


Although one can clearly see this influence, the paintings carry the mark of his home of choice - New York. Much of the visual language and strategies used in the work are not rooted in the European heritage of Impressionism or the Swiss trope of the "naive" craftsman painter.

One can see how American post-war and contemporary artists such as Clifford Still, Alex Katz or the spray paintings of Sterling Ruby have shaped Scherer's visual vocabulary also.




Yves Scherer uses cuteness to create candid images that indirectly address the ineliminable uncertainty of life, which finds immediate comfort in images of inevitable safety, like the loyal relationship between a domesticated pet and its owner.

The love between a pet owner and their pet connects to the consumer culture. The gratification that comes from giving but also receiving love back as a form of expected response is embedded in the connection between buying a good to fulfill a specific need.
