WIPERS

SETTING

Windowless wooden structure with dirt floors, no wind, weather or natural light. Interior is illuminated by 2 panels of solar powered LED lights mounted on wooden beams.

(Metallic surfaces of copper, aluminum and matte black are animated from beneath by windshield wiper motors.)

SOUND

Metal scraping the motors creates vibrations which cause small changes in air pressure, filling the room with sound.

CAST

POWER SUPPLY conducts the concert at 12 Volts DC.

WIPER 1 Light shielding foil on top of Ford F150 windshield wiper motor, stainless steel, zip ties, steel.


WIPER 2 Aluminum foil on top of unknown windshield wiper motor, stainless steel, steel

WIPER 3 Copper on top of VW Cabric Golf windshield wiper motor, Aluminum, steel.

(Wind is big slow sound you feel)
