








Edwin Isford, Amulets (detail), 2018, creatine on string, dimensions variable.

















Lucas Regazzi, *Under the Overpass*, 2017, dirt, salt, hair on stretched white cotton, 21 x 28 inch.




Lucas Regazzi, *Under the Overpass* (detail), 2017, dirt, salt, hair on stretched white cotton, 21 x 28 inch.






Vincent Larouche, Little Peter, 2017, acrylic on canvas, 10×10 inch.




Vincent Larouche, Little Peter (detail), 2017, acrylic on canvas, 10×10 inch.








Catherine Prince, Bad Bunny (detail), 2017, acrylic and oil on Terraskin, 20×26 inch.




Edwin Isford, Amulets, 2018, laser print, blue raspberry BCAA intra-workout catalyst, dimensions variable.






