Ry Rocklen **“Soft Ice”**

In the project room, we will exhibit new sculptures by Los Angeles-based artist Ry Rocklen.

In the center of the project room, “Marble Floor” is a work that Rocklen describes as a “layman’s model of the universe”. This universe consists of differently-sized marbles inlaid into two sheets of particleboard that sit side by side on the gallery floor ready to be walked upon.

In another piece, “No Answer” offers an invitation into infinity. The ringing bell of a phone emanates quietly from deep within a plaster rock. A business card containing the phone’s number sits on the front desk, allowing each visitor to participate in an act that can potentially go on forever.

“Coaled Treasure” stands as a monument to unspent fuel. A styrofoam cooler lined with gold leaf and filled with white charcoal briquets, “Coaled Treasure” consists of different materials in unborn states, brimming with possible uses. Each element has different potentials, but through their proximities to each other, each has become confused and forgotten.

Ry Rocklen was born in Los Angeles and will graduate with an MFA from The University of Southern California in 2006. This is his first exhibition in New York.
