The US called the North Vietnamese Army, the People's Army of Vietnam, and the People's Liberation Armed Forces of South Vietnam the Viet Cong. In the military alphabet, VC is spoken as Victor Charlie. It was shortened to Charlie. The character of Charlie Brown was used by US soldiers to represent the Viet Cong, and US troops assigned themselves the identification with Snoopy. Short Timers were US soldiers who had 100 days left in Vietnam.
