
Teresa Gierzyńska explores moments that take us out of autopilot, forcing us to notice the ephemerality of the world around us. The video works are based on these moments. Constructed based on digitally emulated intra-frame camera movement, inwards and outwards, the video is comprised of Gierzyńska's photographs thrown into a cauldron of artificial intelligence. There are limitations – AI, despite attempts to imitate the workings of human memory and emotions, cannot fully interpret the depth of human memories. AI comes forward with proposals. By following the kaleidoscopically morphing and interpenetrating images, you notice how differently this virtual camera movement is treated – the Latourian *black box* seems to be much more concerned with inventing what draws us inside than with procuring what is outside the frame and adding margins.

Sometimes the predictions created by AI were in line with the reality of the moment in which the photographs were taken, and made Teresa think, "this is how it really was". However, this was often not the case. As AI takes the average of what it understands in the data, it can sometimes get lost, and an uncanny, uncomfortable feeling can emerge when viewing the results. In the case of *About Freedom* (2018-2023), for example, the rainbow in the image wasn't placed on the horizon where it would normally be, it's off-center, and this change of pattern

confused the technology.



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








