## **ARTIST BIO**

Boz Deseo Garden (b. 1997) is an artist and theorist whose interdisciplinary practice works within the material and conceptual impasses articulated by and between Afropessimism and Lacanian psychoanalysis. Through sculpture, video, and critical writing, Garden positions transatlantic slavery as the unconscious ligature for knowledge production, Western notions of form and matter, and psychoanalytic modes of enjoyment. Garden's recent solo and group exhibitions include Timeshare, Los Angeles (2024), Barbara and Art Culver Center for the Arts, Riverside (2023), Petrine, Paris (2023), Fellows of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles (2023), Active Cultures, Los Angeles (2023), Bergen Kunsthall, Norway (2022), Jargon Projects, Chicago (2022), Hammer Museum, Los Angeles (2021), and Los Angeles Municipal Gallery, Los Angeles (2020).
