To distract eyes hellbent on their screens is no easy feat, though these faultless prints have evoked hundreds of testimonies of admiration, amusement, and even disgust—but indifference, never. Their dramatic ensembles display an accuracy pushed to the outermost limits of truth. An abundance of information bordering on abstraction has left many reeling with pleasure—you might even say, like a dream. But Surrealism was yesterday; our era of Unrealism awaits!
