Federico Cantale

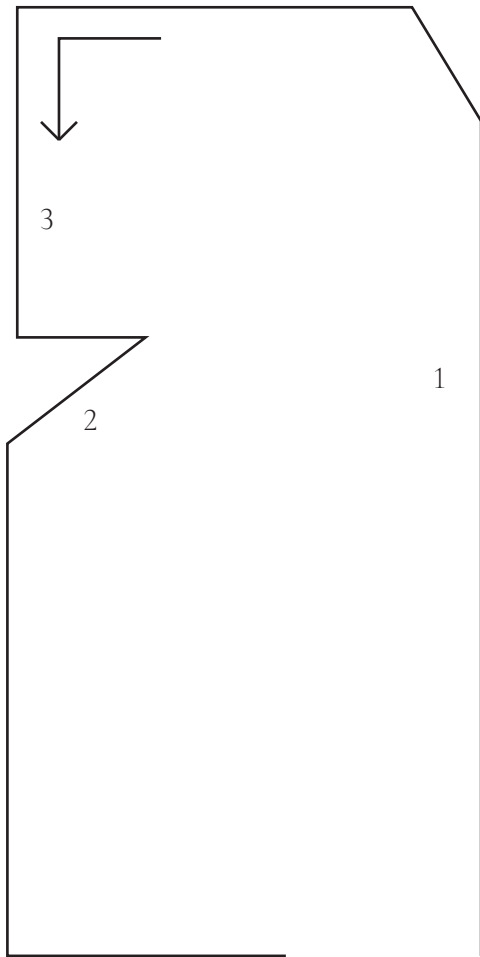
Triangolo is pleased to announce Federico Cantale's first show with the gallery, opening May 18th in Cremona.

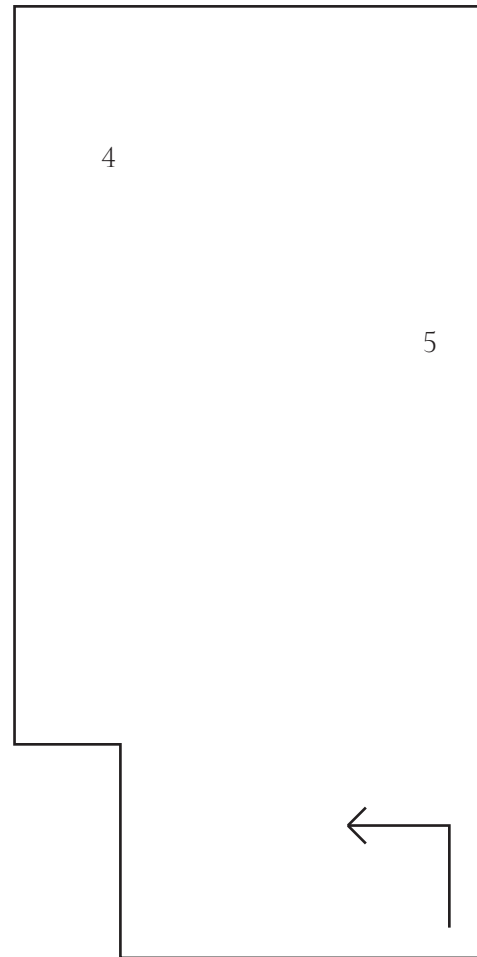
