Dennis Witkin (b. 1992, New York, NY) lives and works in Plainview and Brooklyn. He received his BFA from NYU in 2014. Megan Mi-Ai Lee is an interdisciplinary artist working in Brooklyn, New York. Her work has been shown in exhibitions at Pumice Raft (Toronto, ON; 2024), Room 3557 (Los Angeles, CA; 2023), Godwin-Ternbach Museum (Flushing, NY; 2022), Art Lot (Brooklyn, NY; 2022), and Park View/Paul Soto (Los Angeles, CA; 2020). She is a two-time Canada Council for the Arts grantee and a New York Community Trust Van Lier Fellow. She received her BFA from the Cooper Union School of Art in 2018.

He has exhibited his artwork nationally and internationally at Climate Control (San Francisco, California), Afternoon Projects (Vancouver, CA), Pik Deutz (Cologne, DE), Sinkhole Projects (NYC), Interstate (NYC), Wild Flower (Baltimore, Maryland) and Sleepy Hollow Fine Art (Portland, Maine), among others.

Hunter Foster (b. 1993 Little Rock, AR) is based in New Haven, Connecticut. He received an MFA in Painting and Printmaking from Yale School of Art (2023) and a BFA from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago (2015). He has exhibited work at Perrotin (New York), Good Weather (Chicago), The Anderson at VCUarts (Richmond), Lock Up International (London), The Hills Esthetic Center (Chicago), Gern en Regalia (New York), and Good Weather (North Little Rock), among others.
