Between pixel and pigment. Hybrid painting in post-digital times 07.07.2024 – 10.11.2024

The exhibition, developed in collaboration with the Kunsthalle Bielefeld and taking place simultaneously at both venues, is dedicated to hybrid painting and thus reflects our post-digital present, anchored between the digital and the analogue.

In this large-scale collaboration, the focus is on a painterly way of thinking that has been greatly expanded through the equal interweaving of content and technique of the hybrid. The international artists fundamentally question the traditional medium of painting. To what extent do these changes influence materialities, visual media structures and æsthetics? How do hybrid spaces, bodies that have become fluid and a feeling of being in-between find pictorial equivalents?

With the Kunstakademie Münster as the third project partner, museum practice is combined with academic teaching and research. The

Kunstakademie is organising an accompanying symposium, the contents of which will be published in an academic publication.
