Praxis

Josephine Meckseper, Ryan Trecartin, Meredyth Sparks, Mark Barrow, Linder, Lizzie Fitch

Praxis presents recent developments in the practices of six artists, offering glimpses of new ideas representative of their ongoing bodies of work: Meckseper's appropriations of luxury marketing rhetoric as a means of Imperialist political critique; Trecartin's continued blurring of identity and branding, rendered in two dimensions for photographs originally published in *W Magazine*'s 2010 Art Issue that feature performers from his videos; Sparks' extended explorations of the dialectical processes of abstraction and figuration, which source their content from the punk movement of the 1907s and 80s; Linder's photomontage works born from a similar cultural legacy that highlight the female body as used in advertising and the gestural legacy of Pop; Barrow's study of perception, pattern, and mapping, transposed here for the first time from fabric to paper; and Fitch's burgeoning multi-disciplinary practice that challenges the constancy of materiality and perspective through sculptures and paintings rendered in part by stock imagery purchased and manipulated via computer.
