

In her exhibition, Ines Lechleitner shows a series of photographs displaying the region around the mountain massif 'La Chartreuse' in France, bordering the monastery 'Grande Chartreuse' founded by 'Bruno from Cologne'. The traditional 'Selet' cheese is hand-made in the cheese dairy 'Le Habert' in Entremont-Le-Vieux. In the two larger photographs, Lechleitner simulates the cheesemakers' view onto the mountain in the surrounding landscape and thereby mixes imagination/clichée and reality, nature's form and its perception.
