







Finn Theuws

Finn Theuws was born in 1997 in Amsterdam. Working in sculpture, his practice is driven by a fascination with how the inanimate can convey meaning and reciprocally influence the human subject.

Flora Fritz

Flora Fritz is a German painter born in 1998.

Greta Eimulytė

Greta Eimulytė born in 1999 lives and works between Vilnius and Amsterdam. Her creative expression varies from drawing and text to sculpture, video and sound installations.

Levi van Gelder


Levi van Gelder born in 1995 is an artist living and working in Amsterdam, working in performance, writing, sculpture and video work. In his work, he explores fanfiction as a tool for queer resistance and counterfactual reclamation of histories and fictions.

Lizzy Deacon

Lizzy Deacon born in 1999 is a British artist living and working between Amsterdam and London. She works in video, drawing and sculpture.

Lorian Gwynn

Lorian Gwynn born in 2001 is a painter based in Amsterdam that works around the themes of family history, memories and what is currently happening around her.



Ruoru Mou

Ruoru Mou born in 1997 in Italy lives and works between Amsterdam and Florence. Through making associations between the personal, handcrafted and industrially metabolised materials, the works question our relationship to value, hierarchies of production and material orders of power.

Sofía Salazar Rosales

Sofía Salazar Rosales born in 1999 in Ecuador lives and works between Amsterdam and Paris. Salazar Rosales's work develops from a sentence she wrote: "Hay cuerpos cansados por el viaje que buscan enraizarse" (There are bodies tired from the journey that seek to root). Her interest focuses on how objects have a potential to show social, political, and economic contexts, specifically linked to the displacement of humans, goods and other objects.

Swan Lee

Swan Lee, a South Korean-born artist currently based in Amsterdam, works across writing and various media to create immersive experiences often described as expanded cinema.

Tumelo Mtimkhulu

Tumelo Mtimkhulu is an artist from Johannesburg, South Africa, currently based in Amsterdam. He employs visual and written text so as to grapple with questions of how to negotiate the personal and histories that one is heir to. He conceives of these histories as 'texts' in themselves and the human being as a site onto which these histories/experiences/texts are written, effaced, rewritten and superimposed onto existing 'texts'.
