Noah Barker *Cloudscape* December 12th - February 15th, 2024

They sat gazing out the sheet glass window as the sun rose over the Valley of Heart's Content. Precipitation swept off the sea by Santa Anas had climbed up and over the first coastal mounds to mix with haze. Through the hushed mist hangars could be deciphered against the southern tip of the bay. Boxed laboratories surrounded them, none distinctive enough to be named. On the horizon were granular structures dissolving sight and self into the scene.

Climate Control is pleased to present Cloudscape, an exhibition by Noah Barker. The presentation incorporates works from the past five years with a new series of mobiles developed alongside a forthcoming interview of the artist. Rather than focusing on Barker's work, the artist discussed preoccupying historical paradigms. The mobiles have resulted from attempts at formulating models for the events which compose them.
