The object placed under the globe can be changed for any item the curator or owner desires.

Joav BarEl was a pivotal figure in the Israeli avant-garde of the 1960s and '70s. An artist, lecturer, art critic, and cultural commentator at large, he had a profound impact on his generation. Barel received posthumous solo exhibitions at Frieze New York (2013), and Tempo Rubato, Tel Aviv (2012); In 2004, BarEl had a retrospective exhibition at the Tel Aviv Museum of Art. He participated in group exhibitions held at: the Artists' Association, Tel Aviv (1972); Tel Aviv Museum of Art (1971, 1968, and 1966); Hanegev Museum, Beer Sheva, Israel (1965); and Haifa Museum of Art (1960 and 1958).
