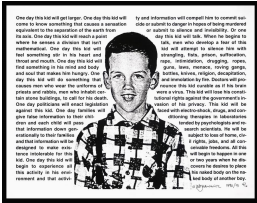

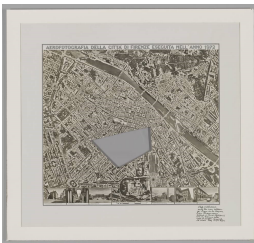

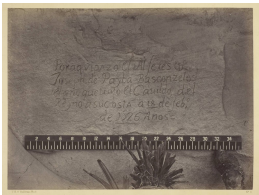

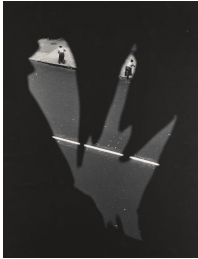

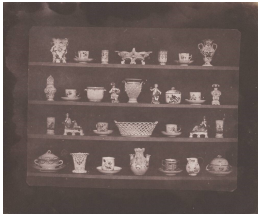

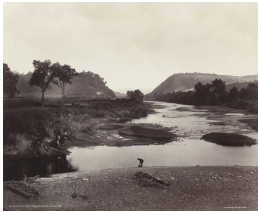


William Eggleston

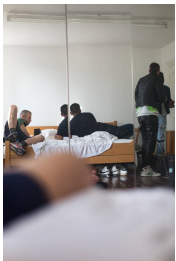
