## Biography

Diogo Pinto (born in Lisbon) is an artist and curator based in Basel. He obtained in 2016 a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the Faculty of Fine-Arts, University of Lisbon, and in 2021 a Master of Fine Arts from the Institute Art Gender Nature HGK Basel FHNW. He has recently presented projects at Dietikon Projektraum, Galerias Municipais, MONITOR Gallery, Faltpavillon, Spirit Shop, June Art Fair, Ausstellungsraum Klingental, Kunsthalle Palazzo, and Kunsthaus Baselland. He co-edited and co-authored the publications *This is a Bar... ou Praia de Banhos* (2022), *Dos Olhos à sua Ausência - António Ramos Rosa* (2020), and *Lâmina Olhar Animal - Maria Lino* (2019). He was co-director and co-founder of the exhibition project Ascensor (2018 – 2020) and is currently part of the curatorial team at Plattform.
